Webinar 1: U.S. EPA Regulations and CHP

Webinar participants will learn the expected impacts of a suite of U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) rules on CHP implementation and operation. Regulations discussed will include air (Mercury and Air Toxics Standards and the Cross-State Air Pollution rule), water/solid waste (Cooling Water Intake Structures and Coal Combustion Residuals rules), and industrial/commercial/institutional boilers (National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants).

Webinar 2: Showcasing Model Utility IEE Programs

February 7, 2012, 12:00 – 1:00 p.m. (Eastern Time)

During this Webinar, utilities that have implemented successful energy efficiency programs for industrial customers will showcase their design and implementation approaches to other utilities, industrial customers, and key stakeholders.

Webinar 3: Elevating IEE Regulatory Issues for Commissioners

March 6, 2012, 12:00 – 1:00 p.m. (Eastern Time)

This Webinar will examine regulatory issues that impact utility incentive programs, such as flexibility and consistency in offerings, free-ridership, and risk mitigation techniques. Utility, commission, and industrial customer viewpoints will be shared.
